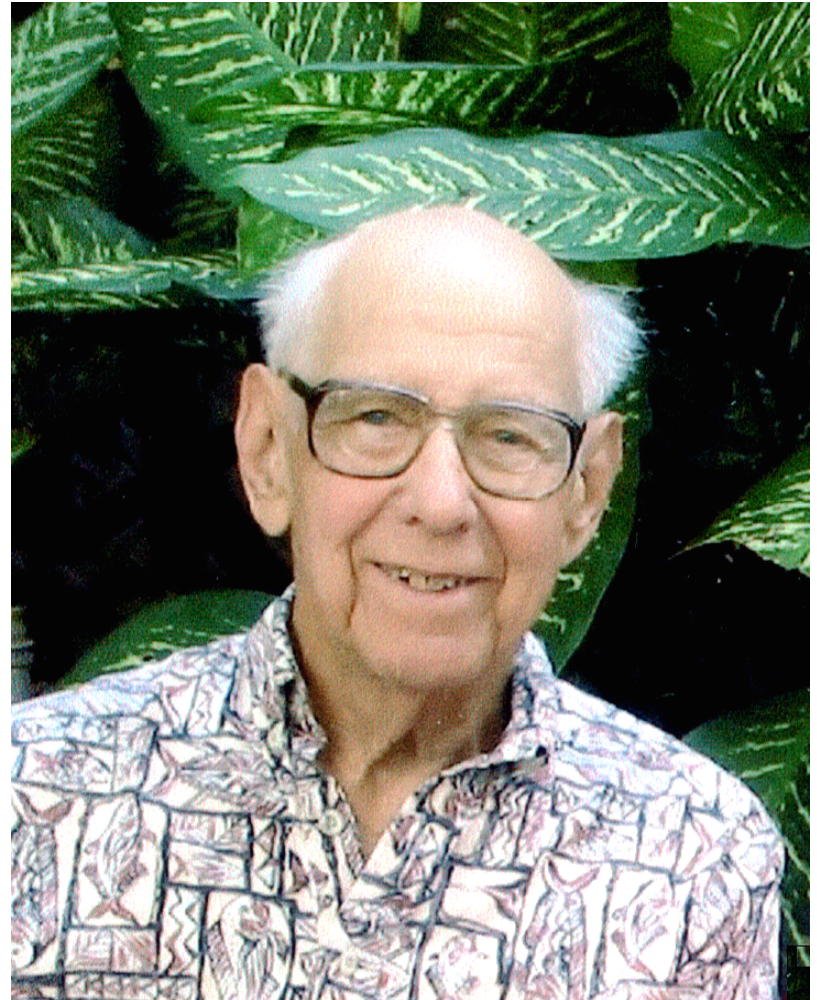
And that is dying.
